BOARD PAPER REFERENCE – GLA 35/10.3 – CONTINUATION OF THE FORESTRY PILOT

<u>Issue</u>

1. Extending the period of the Forestry pilot

Recommendations

- 2. The GLA will continue to apply the lighter touch pilot until the exclusions consultation by Defra concludes
- 3. The GLA will also consider removal of the application fee for forestry only labour providers

Background

- 4. The Forestry pilot has been an effective test of a lighter touch approach. It is identified that the level of non-compliance is relatively low compared to the licensing community as a whole.
- 5. The Written Ministerial Statement confirmed that Defra would consult on the removal of forestry from licensing, The GLA therefore concludes that although the pilot has operated for over a year it is sensible to continue it in these circumstances.
- 6. However, the GLA is concerned that announcements on this proposal may suggest to forestry only labour providers that it is acceptable not to renew their licences; it is not, and remains a criminal offence.
- 7. Therefore the GLA has secured Ministerial approval not to levy renewal fees to forestry only labour providers until the completion of the consultation exercise.

(NB: Defra confirmation of 7 is still awaited)
