- GLA to seek independent legal advice on applicability of AWO in the GLA areas.
- GLA to check progress with Defra with reviewing the farmer-to-farmer exclusion.
- At the next opportunity, the GLA to review the licence application form with a view to identifying individuals other than Directors or those named on the licence to act as gangmasters, who were the controlling powers behind companies.
- GLA to consider how best to produce an analysis of inspection results identifying the main areas of weakness identified, to inform the industry.
- GLA to explain its policy for the handling of intelligence how it can be submitted, is processed and how it may be acknowledged and feedback provided.
