Question:

To ask the Secretary of State for the Home Department, whether her Department's planned consultation on the Gangmasters Licensing Authority (GLA) will consider (a) extension of the remit of the GLA into further labour sectors and (b) how the core licence-monitoring and intelligence-gathering function of the GLA can be protected?
