



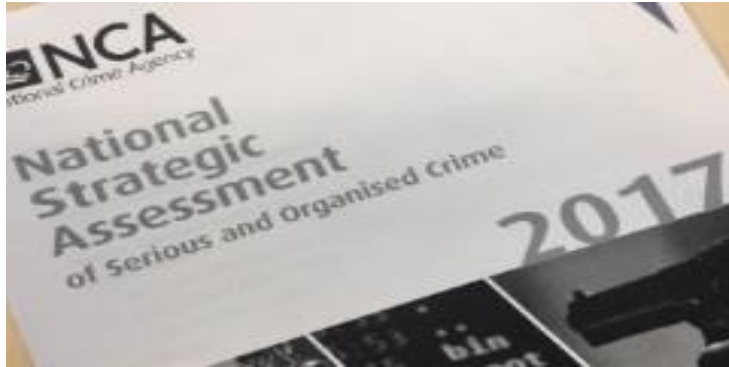

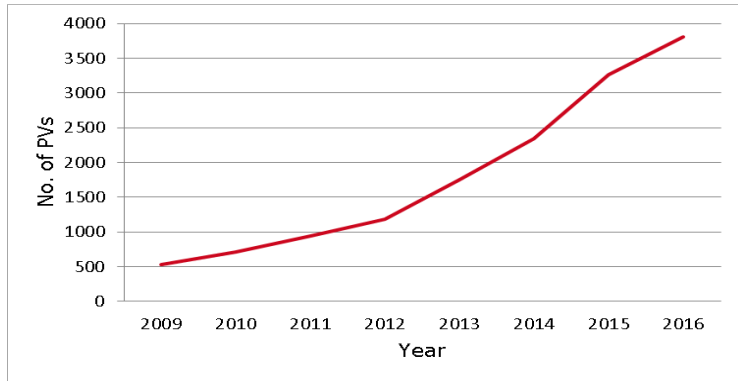

What We've Achieved

- More than 400 live operations targeting modern slavery in the UK.
- Project AIDANT – in May and June led to 111 arrests in the UK and some 130 people being encountered who may be considered as victims.
- Hundreds of potential victims rescued in UK and overseas.
